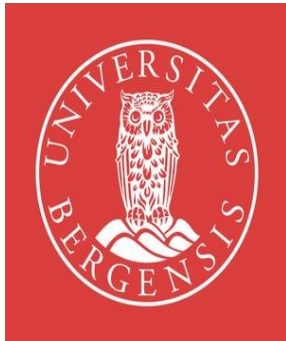

# EASSH: European Alliance for SSH

- Largest advocacy and science policy organisation for the social sciences and humanities in Europe.
  - Members are universities and European-wide disciplinary associations
  - Interface SSH researchers and policy makers
  - Make more visible SSH research results and contribution

- **Engage with Science policy** to design research investment on our research needs, methods, and questions

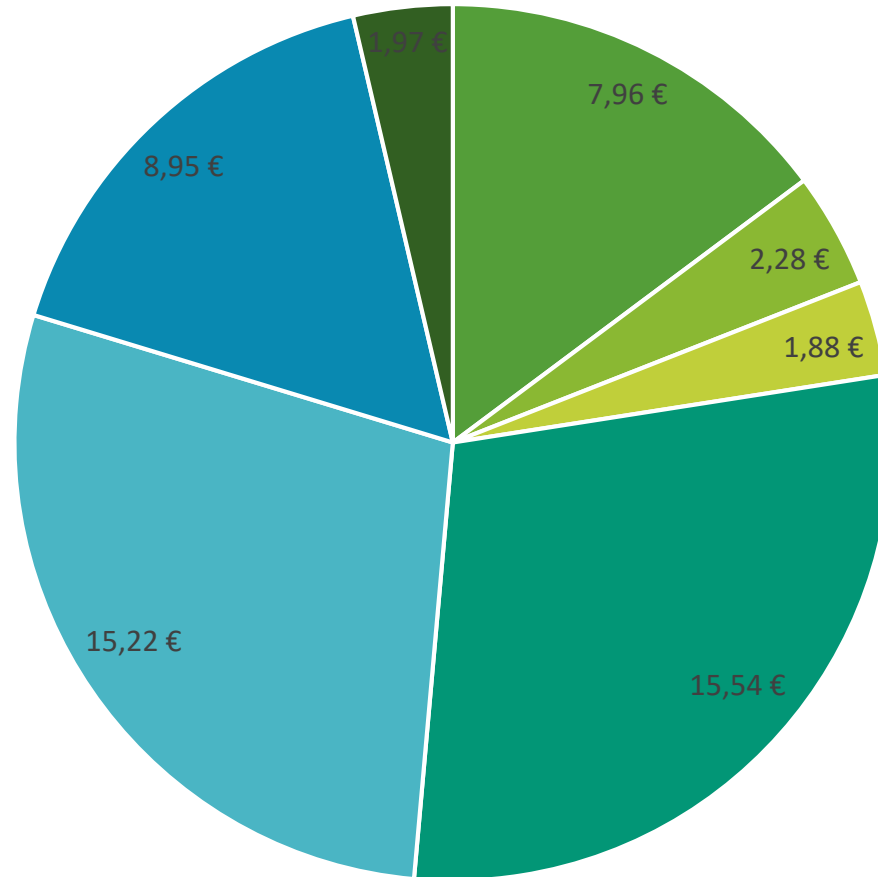


# Funding Research in Humanities

- Core funding to higher education at National levels: inst and project funding
- Public National funding – Ministries/Research funding councils
- European funding
- Philanthropy, private foundations (regional, national, etc.)

# Policy for SSH in Europe

- Dedicated research funding for SSH at National levels
- European funding: integration of H and SS in all clusters
- Eur Cultural Heritage cloud to be integrated in the EOSC
- More Eur Joint Partnerships SSH driven
- Knowledge Innovation Communities
- EIT/Social Innovation Platform
- Eur Research Area: humanities contribution
- Eur Higher Education Area: role of all disciplines in reforming HE
- Skills and Jobs: the importance of soft skills



# SSH integration in global S&T strategies

- Coordinated research funding strategies for SSH
- SSH integration in National S&T research programmes (eg Japan, South Africa, Canada, US, Brazil, etc.): implementation mechanisms
- Open Science in Europe and beyond: value of SSH and its wide research outputs
- Philanthropy and national funding for research
- Sustainable Development Goals: culture, principles and values
- Cross borders collaborations: local and global humanities
