SSH in Horizon Europe Added value

- Single disciplines cannot address alone the complex current societal challenges
- Interactions between STEM* and SSH foster multi, trans and interdisciplinary approaches
- When designing new policies, we need to examine the societal impacts of science and research
- It is important to keep a 'human centric' focus across all research areas
- SSH across all research and innovation areas: 'Horizontal issues'
- * STEM: Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics


Monitoring reports H2020 SSH-flagged topics from 2014 until 2018


