## Goal of the Mission: 100 living labs and lighthouses to lead the transition towards healthy soils by 2030

#### **Specific objectives:**

- 1. Reduce desertification
- 2. Conserve soil organic carbon stocks
- 3. Stop **soil sealing** and increase re-use of **urban soils**
- 4. Reduce **soil pollution** and enhance **restoration**

- 5. Prevent erosion
- 6. Improve soil structure to enhance soil biodiversity
- 7. Reduce the **EU global footprint on soils**
- 8. Improve **soil literacy** in society



Each specific objective is backed by **one or more quantified targets** and **measurable indicators**. Objectives apply to **all types of land use**.






### **How is the Mission implemented?**

Policy makers, advisors, teachers, pupils, companies, consumers, citizens etc. engagement sessions beyond living labs and lighthouses, communication material, training curricula for different target groups and specialised "soil advisors"

**Experts and stakeholders** to reach out to citizens:
Citizen science, soil passport



#### Researchers

interdisciplinary research that includes social sciences and explores behavioural and societal changes

#### **Practitioners**

engagement sessions, lighthouses and living labs where to experiment on the ground and showcase good practices





## What does citizen engagement mean in the framework of the mission A soil Deal for Europe?

Engagement is understood as being active in nature, involving a two-way process between those being engaged and those seeking the engagement







## Why is citizen engagement important?



- Legitimacy and acceptance
- Public value represents not just what citizens demand today, but what they may need or desire in the future
- Co-designing and co-implementing with citizens, scientists, innovators, land managers, farmers, spatial planners, etc. ensure that the Mission responds to local needs and long-term results.





## Increase soil literacy in society across the EU – long-term targets

- Awareness of the societal role and value of soil is increased amongst EU citizens, including stakeholders and policy makers
- Soil health is firmly embedded in schools and educational curricula, to enable citizens' behavioural change towards the adoption of sustainable practices both individually and collectively
- Citizen involvement in soil and land-related issues is improved at all levels
- Practitioners and stakeholders have access to appropriate information and training to improve skills and to support the adoption of sustainable land management practices






