Mission Ocean is embraced in the 10 year **Swedish Research and Innovation program for Ocean and Water**, one of 13 interlinked programs to address prioritized societal challenges through research and innovation .

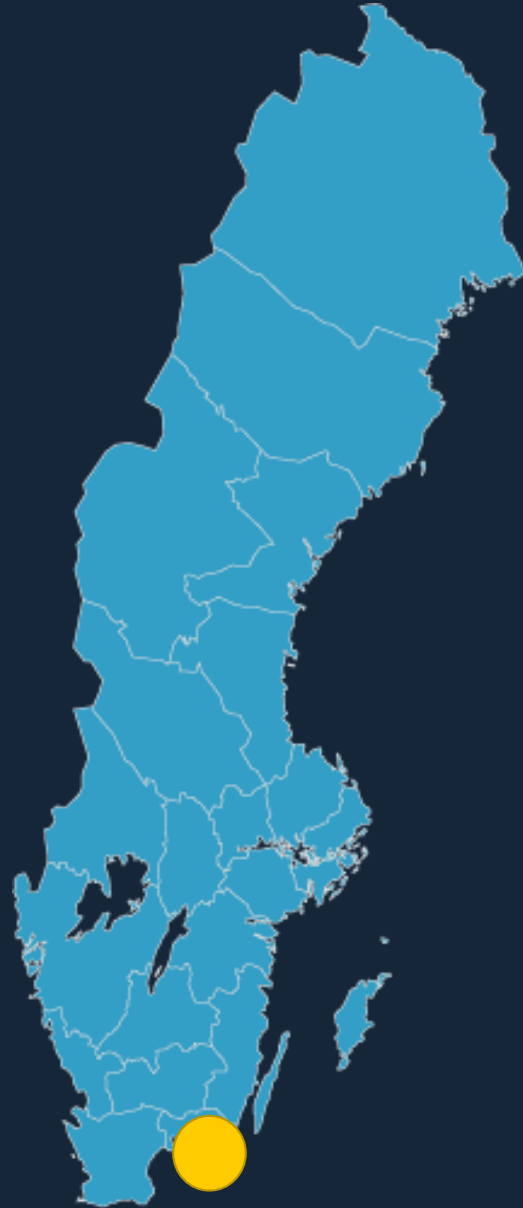

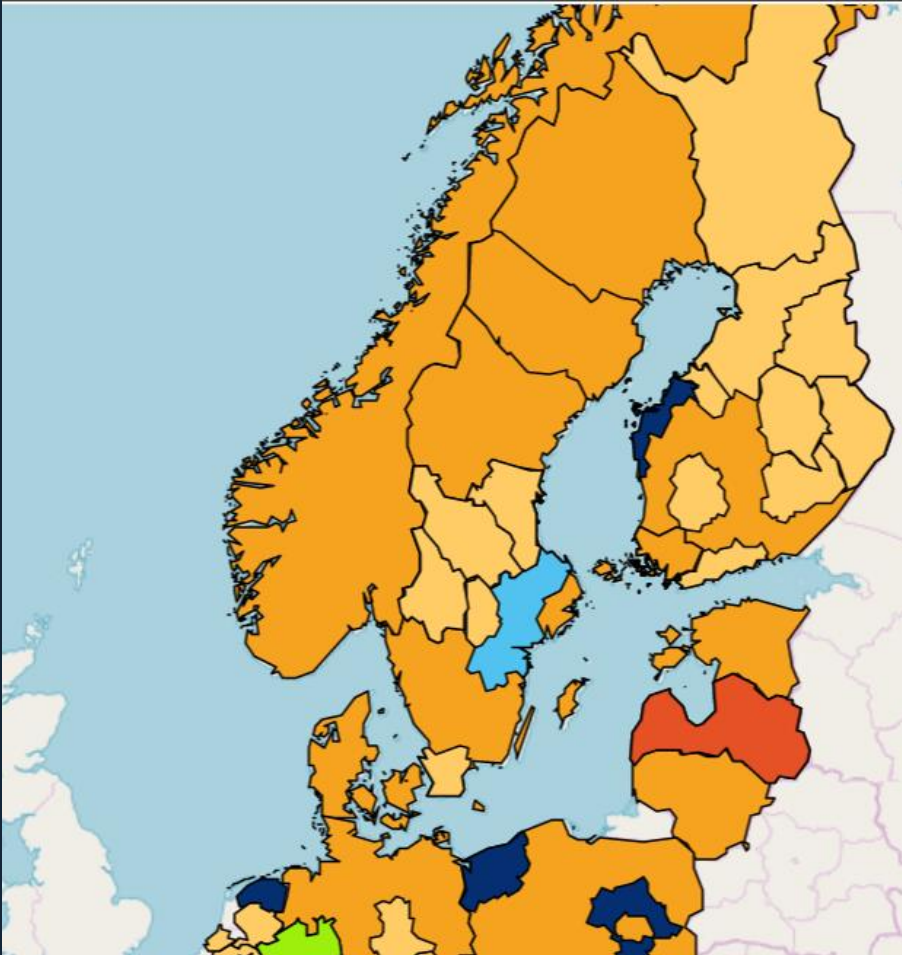
Blekinge – A region on a Mission
